Our mission is to assure sanctuary for homeless animals and encourage responsible pet ownership

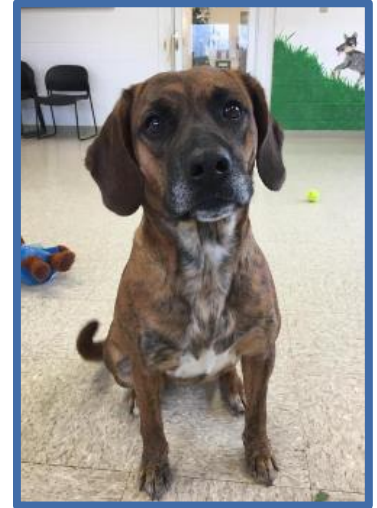
Kroger's "Community Rewards" Program Benefits Homeless Animals
